Dear Parents/Carers

As you will be aware through news coverage the Government is frequently updating their response to the global issue of Coronavirus. We are monitoring the situation daily and following all nationally recommended advice to protect students and staff. Please assist us by following government advice in terms of isolating where symptoms of a new persistent cough or high temperature are present. Pupil absence should be reported to school each day by 8.35am.

If you have been advised to isolate your child at home online learning can be undertaken through the following platforms on our website: Tassomai, GCSE Pod, Hegarty Maths and Renaissance Reading (Year 7 and 8 only). Homework that has been set each day is accessible via Classcharts. Pupils should also aim to read for at least 30 minutes each day.

Important updates will be communicated via our usual systems of School Gateway and the school website. It would be helpful if all parents/carers could download the Gateway app onto mobile devices to ensure that you receive prompt communication. **It is essential that the school has your up to date contact details and that you check the school website regularly.**

In the event of school closure, a programme of work would be set to support your daughter's learning. This work would be set electronically through the 'Classcharts' link on our website. Please log on using the parental codes supplied last week.
